6. The following plan to permit members to get dues credit for work performed was reinstated for 2017 due to most of the mower cost being covered by donations. This is now the third notice for the by-laws change.  
  
"Dale discussed a plan to get members to help that he had seen at other clubs. There would be a sign-up book in the shed and each time a member would help at the field he would note this in the book.
